



ELCON's Affiliate Program

ELCON membership is available only to large electricity consumers. However, in response to inquiries, in 1996 ELCON created an Affiliate Program so that companies and associations who do not qualify for ELCON membership can participate, although in a limited way.

Who Becomes an ELCON Affiliate?

ELCON affiliates are primarily those companies and associations that either seek more extensive contact with ELCON members or those that wish to support ELCON's legislative and regulatory advocacy efforts. In the past many ELCON affiliates have been utilities and electricity marketers, consulting firms, real estate management companies, and industrial trade associations. Law firms are not eligible.

How Do ELCON Affiliates Benefit?

- ELCON Affiliates have the opportunity to join ELCON members three times a year at our "Members Only" Workshops and Dinners.
- ELCON Affiliates have access to ELCON's membership directory and the directory of State Industrial User Groups.
- ELCON Affiliates receive the monthly "Law Developments Report" detailing current legal issues of importance to large electricity customers that are pending before FERC and in federal courts.
- ELCON Affiliates receive selected Information Memos on developing legislative and regulatory electricity issues.

These benefits are available ONLY to ELCON members and Affiliates.
